**WHAT:** SF Bay Ferry will begin accepting Clipper® cards on the Vallejo ferry and Route 200 buses beginning Monday, Nov. 3, 2014.

With the advent of Clipper® on the Vallejo/SF route, San Francisco Bay Ferry now accepts Clipper® on all service routes. Starting Nov. 3, ferry customers can purchase Clipper® cards and load E-Cash on their cards at the Vallejo Ferry Terminal ticket office.

Clipper® is a reloadable transit fare payment card that can be used on San Francisco Bay Ferry, Soltrans, Muni, BART, AC Transit, VTA, SamTrans, Caltrain, and Golden Gate Transit.
