WHO: San Francisco Bay Ferry

WHAT: San Francisco Bay Ferry invites the public to ride its Alameda/Oakland service in the 38th Annual Lighted Yacht Parade. This Bay Area tradition features festively decorated boats of all descriptions as they cruise along the estuary in competition for prizes. The public can participate in the festivities by riding the SF Bay Ferry boat that is entered into the competition.

WHEN: Saturday, December 6, 2014

WHERE: The special Lighted Yacht Parade ferry service is only available from the Alameda Main Street ferry terminal located at 2990 Main Street. The ferry departs from Main Street at 5:15 p.m. and returns to the terminal at 6:45 p.m.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

As in past years, the ferry service is collecting toys onboard for the Oakland Firefighters Random Acts Toys program. As a special thank you, customers donating a toy may ride the parade ferry for free. Fares for all others are:

- Adults \$6.25
- Youth 5 to 18 \$3.10
- Children under 5 ride for free
- Seniors, the disabled, and Medicare recipients \$3.10

Please note that Clipper cards are not accepted for this event. Space is limited and available on a first-come, first-served basis; tickets may be purchased onboard the ferry. Onboard food and beverage service is available. Free parking is provided at the Main Street terminal.
