SAN FRANCISCO BAY FERRY ANNOUNCES FARE CHANGE

WHO: San Francisco Bay Ferry

WHAT: The ferry service will implement a scheduled fare change on July 1, 2015. This change is part of a five-year fare program that was approved by the WETA Board of Directors in September 2014 and is designed to offset projected operating cost increases.

Key fare changes:

- **Alameda/Oakland/SF:** Adult cash fare will increase from \$6.25 to \$6.40. Clipper adult fare will change from \$4.75 to \$4.80.
- **Harbor Bay/SF:** Adult cash fare will increase from \$6.50 to \$6.70. The adult Clipper fare will not change.
- **SSF/East Bay:** Adult cash fare will increase from \$7.00 to \$7.40. Clipper adult fare will change \$7.00 to \$7.20.
- **Vallejo/SF:** Adult cash fare will increase from \$13.00 to \$13.40. The Clipper adult fare will increase from \$9.75 to \$10.10. Youth, Senior and Disabled fares increase from \$6.50 to \$6.70. Monthly pass will increase from \$290.00 to \$307.00
