**SF BAY FERRY TO PROVIDE ADDITIONAL SERVICE DURING SUSPENSION OF
BART TRANSBAY OPERATIONS**

WHO: SF Bay Ferry

WHAT: On September 5-7, 2015, SF Bay Ferry will double its usual weekend service on the Alameda/Oakland/San Francisco route, and enhance service on the Vallejo/San Francisco route due to the closure of the Transbay Tube for BART repairs. Details under “NEWS” at www.sanfranciscobayferry.com.

Ferry riders are encouraged to arrive early and have alternate back-up plans as it is unknown what the rider volume will be.

WHEN: September 5-7, 2015

WHY: BART will close the West Oakland Station and will not run trains between West Oakland and Embarcadero stations while it repairs a critical section of track near the Transbay Tube. To learn more visit www.bart.gov.
