**SAN FRANCISCO BAY FERRY TO PARTICIPATE IN
42nd ANNUAL LIGHTED YACHT PARADE**

WHO: San Francisco Bay Ferry

WHAT: San Francisco Bay Ferry invites the public to ride with us in the 42nd Annual Lighted Yacht Parade in Alameda this Saturday. This beloved Bay Area tradition features festively decorated boats of all types in a colorful parade through the Oakland Estuary. The public can participate in the festivities by riding aboard San Francisco Bay Ferry's entry in the parade.

WHEN: Saturday, December 1, 2018. Boarding begins at 5 p.m., departure at 5:15.

WHERE: Alameda Main Street Ferry Terminal at 2990 Main Street in Alameda.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

Passengers donating a new, unwrapped toy will ride for free on a first-come, first-served basis. (One passenger per toy.) Toys will be donated to the local Toys for Tots drive. Passengers can also pay the cash fare to ride aboard the ferry in the parade.

- Adults: \$7.00
- Youth (5-18), Seniors (65+), Disabled: \$3.50
- Children Under 5 Ride Free

Clipper cards cannot be used for this event. Space is limited and boarding occurs on a first-come, first-served basis. Tickets may be purchased onboard the ferry at time of departure. Onboard food and beverage service is available. Free parking is provided at the Main Street terminal. The ferry is scheduled to return to the Alameda Main Street Ferry Terminal for disembarkation at 6:45 p.m.
